

Asheboro High School Announces New Baseball Coach

Asheboro High School Athletic Director Wes Berrier has announced the Blue Comets new varsity baseball coach is Bradley Rudisill:

Please help me congratulate our new AHS Head Baseball Coach Bradley Rudisill along with his wife Kelly, daughter Blaire, and son William who are super excited to be part of the Blue Comet Family!!

Coach Rudisill is from Catawba, NC where he attended Bandys High School and played baseball for four years.

After high school he attended Rockingham CC to play baseball. Coach Rudisill then transferred to Appalachian State where he got his degree in Health Education with minors in Criminal Justice and Psychology. He also started his coaching career in Boone, under NCBCA Hall of Fame Coach Pete Hardee.

After graduating from Appalachian State University, Coach Rudisill became the Recruiting Coordinator/Pitching Coach at Montreat College. Coach Rudisill then became the Head Baseball Coach and PE teacher at South Pointe High School in Rock Hill, SC. During his time at South Pointe the team won the Regional Championship and was named Region 3 4a Coach of the year in 2017.

He then made the move back to North Carolina and accepted the Head Coach position and PE position at Davie County High School. In 2018, Davie County had a historic season going 24-3 winning the CPC Regular Season Championship before falling in the 3rd round of the 4a Playoffs. During 2019 Davie County was ranked as high as 3rd in the Nation by MaxPreps and finished the season ranked in the top 50 in the Nation. In 2020 Davie County was ranked preseason 61st in the nation with a team that brought back a lot of starters from 2019. However that season was cut short by the Covid Pandemic.

During his time at Davie County he was named CPC Coach of the Year, Region 7 Coach of the Year, and Region 7 Field of the Year. Davie County saw over 20 baseball athletes move on to play college baseball during his 4 years at the helm of the War Eagles. After a family move Coach Rudisill took the reins of Bunker Hill High School and has spent the last 3 years as an EC Teacher and Baseball Coach.

Coach Rudisill has been involved with the North Carolina Baseball Coaches Association since starting coaching and has served as the Region 7 Representative since 2019. He has been head coach of the Body Armor State Games twice. In 2023 Region 7 won the Gold Medal and in 2024 lost in the Bronze Medal Game to Region 5. He has had 5 players go on to play at the professional level (Carson Whisenhunt LHP SF Giants, Hunter Harvey RHP Washington Nationals, Hayden Deal LHP Atlanta Braves, Ryder Jones 3rd Base SF Giants, and Utah Jones MIF Seattle Mariners)

Coach Rudisill is excited to be back in the area with his family and absolutely pumped to be taking over a historic and proud Asheboro Baseball Program.

“From the time I stepped foot on campus and saw the attention to detail within the renovated school building to the athletic facilities. And then walking the grounds of the newly renovated Historic McCrary Park, I feel like I have hit the jackpot! I get a close community who loves it's baseball from Asheboro High School to the Zoo Keepers to Randolph County Post 45. There is so much rich baseball tradition within this community.
